**FACTS**

**WHAT DOES THE SCOTT COUNTY STATE BANK (“SCSB”) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?**

**Why?**

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to restrict some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

**What?**

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- social security number and income
- account balances and payment history
- credit history and credit scores

When you close your account, we continue to share information about you according to our policies.

**How?**

All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business – to process transactions, maintain customer accounts, and report to credit bureaus. In the section below, we list all the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ information; the reasons The Scott County State Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

## WHAT DOES THE SCOTT COUNTY STATE BANK (“SCSB”) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

### Sharing Practices

<b>How often does SCSB notify me about their practices?</b>	We must notify you about our sharing practices when you open an account and each year while you are a customer.
<b>How does SCSB protect my personal information?</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
<b>How does SCSB collect my personal information?</b>	We collect personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ open an account or deposit money</li><li>▪ pay your bills or apply for a loan</li><li>▪ use your credit or debit card</li></ul> We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	Federal law gives you the right to limit sharing only for <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness</li><li>▪ affiliates to market to you</li><li>▪ nonaffiliates to market to you</li></ul> State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing

### Definitions

<b>Everyday business purposes</b>	The actions necessary by financial companies to run their business and manage customer accounts, such as <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ processing transactions, mailing, and auditing services</li><li>▪ providing information to credit bureaus</li><li>▪ responding to court orders and legal investigations</li></ul>
<b>Affiliates</b>	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Our affiliates include companies with The Scott County State Bank name; and nonfinancial companies such as the Title Center of Greater Kentucky, LLC and Community Bank Shares of Indiana, Inc, which is bank holding company that owns The Scott County State Bank and Your Community Bank.</li></ul>
<b>Nonaffiliates</b>	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ The Scott County State Bank may share information with nonaffiliated third parties such as mortgage companies, insurance companies, direct marketing companies, nonprofit organizations or its credit card issuer Silverton Bank or First Bank Card.</li></ul>
<b>Joint Marketing</b>	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ The Scott County State Bank has a joint marketing relationship with Silverton Bank and First Bank Card.</li></ul>
